Background

Planted forests are increasing world wide and societies are becoming more and more reliant on a range of wood and non-wood products as well as ecosystem services provided by tree plantations. This International Congress will deal with the role of planted forests in society, economy and environment.

While there are many different types of plantations established for different purposes, the majority of plantations have been established with the aim of producing timber and other wood products. In some parts of the world, plantations have been established with the explicit aim to reduce the reliance on native forests. Increasingly, plantations are established to meet also other objectives such as land rehabilitation, erosion control, control of the water table etc.

It is thus timely to ask, to what extent plantations can provide wood products and ecosystem goods and services, and how this can be supported through policies and market mechanisms.

The Union of Forest Owners of Southern Europe, the EU-funded NETFOP (Networking Forest Plantations in a Crowded World) project and the European Institute of Cultivated Forests (IEFC), are organising this event with support of CIFOR, FAO, IUFRO, IUCN and other organizations to present the current knowledge and stimulate the debate about these issues.
