Visa, regulatory supporting documents

- For residents of the European Union: no visa is required.
- For non-EU resident: a visa may be required depending on the country and length of stay.

Travelling to Bordeaux: Loss/delay of baggage

In case of any baggage loss or delay, it is responsibility of the air company, so please complete the required formalities at the airport.

You are advised to travel smart by ensuring that you have a change of clothing in your hand luggage which will be useful should you lose or experience delays in obtaining your luggage. Additionally, at

the point of boarding your connecting flight, kindly request the respective airline staff to confirm that your luggage, as indicated in the boarding pass, is indeed loaded onto the aircraft.

Bordeaux has a significant bus and tram network throughout the urban community. Follow this link to see all the information on this network : <https://www.infotbm.com/en>

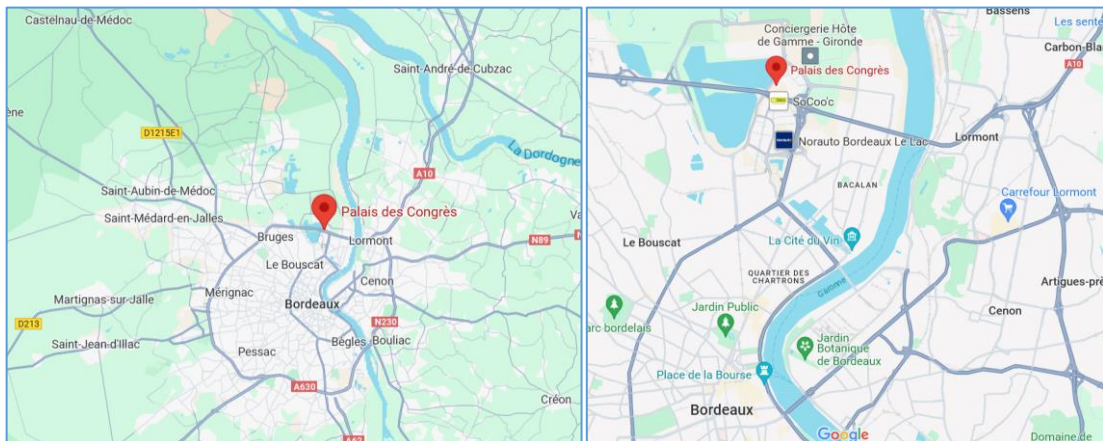
From the airport, it is possible to reach the "Palais des congrès" and nearby hotels in 1 hour at any time of the day, by taking tram A, change at "Porte de Bourgogne", then tram C (direction "Bordeaux Parc des expositions").

From the SNCF station, it is possible to reach the "Palais des congrès" and nearby hotels in half an hour at any time of the day, by taking tram C (direction "Bordeaux Parc des expositions").

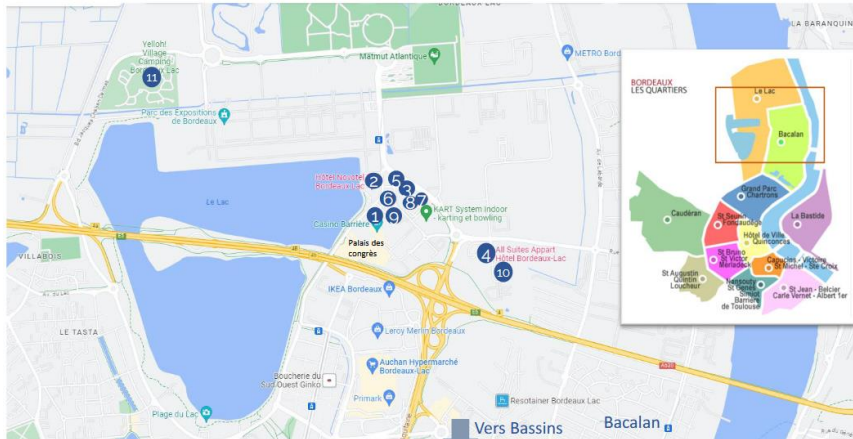

The current in France has a voltage of 230 V with a frequency of 50 Hz. The sockets are European, type E.
